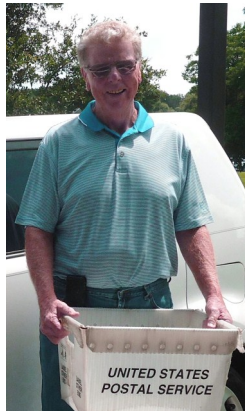

When he's not on the road for Hospice, he can be found on the golf course or working in his large yard.

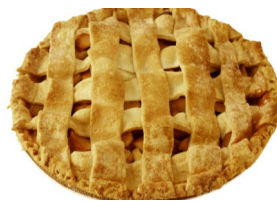
He also makes appearances at Fundraising events on the arm of our CEO, Mary Ellen Poe.
