Dr. Jillian Ramsammy is the vice president for Institutional Effectiveness and College Relations at the College of Central Florida where she provides leadership for Marketing and Public Relations, Grants Funding, Institutional Effectiveness and the Appleton Museum of Art. Previously, she served as the college's legislative liaison and equity officer and was the director of the college's Hampton Center with administrative oversight for selected college-wide community programs and diversity initiatives. She began her tenure at the college as the manager of operations for the Cultural and Conference Centers.

Before joining CF in 2002, Dr. Ramsammy was the chief of education and outreach for Miami-Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs where she managed the development and implementation of programs and services in support of arts education, nonprofit cultural education and arts administration. She began her career in 1987, first as a museum educator for Museum of Broadcasting in New York and then as program assistant for Lincoln Center of the Performing Arts Institute.
